



Foreign vaccines, Green Pass and equivalent certifications Guidelines and procedure

Since last September 1st, the Green Pass/EU Digital COVID certificate is required to access all the Scuola facilities. In the absence of proper certification, it is not allowed to access to the School's facilities, activities and services in any case.

The Green Pass certifies one of the following conditions:

- having completed the prescribed anti-SARS-CoV-2 vaccination course since at least 14 days (a temporary Certificate is issued after the 1st dose and it is valid from the 15th day after the vaccine until the date of the 2nd dose, no more than 42 days after the 1st dose – see below for more instructions). This Green Pass is valid for 9 months;
- be cured of COVID-19 (the validity of the healing certificate lasts 180 days from the date of the first positive swab). This Green Pass is valid for 6 months;
- having made a molecular or antigenic swab in the 48 hours, prior to entering the school, with a negative result. In this case, the Green Pass is valid for 48 hours only;

Non-vaccinated EU and Extra-EU citizens

In case of short stays (**up to one month**) foreigners can:

- have a swab test that can be made at labs or pharmacies, which is equivalent to a green pass valid for 48 hours.

In case of longer stays (**one month or more**) foreigners, who need to be vaccinated, should:

- get a Fiscal Code and enrol in the Regional Health Service. The registration can be done just after the Stay Permit application (for people who stay more than 3 months)

Or

- get a ENI code (for European citizens) or STP code (for non-EU citizens), providing that one already has a Fiscal Code, which will allow to access the vaccination campaign.

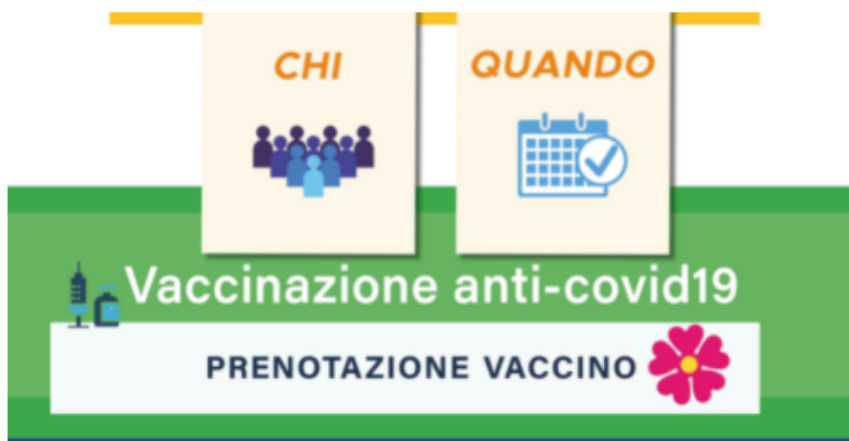
Second dose for EU and Extra-EU citizens

- those who made a first dose vaccination in **EU** can access the Scuola between the 15th and 42nd day after vaccination, regardless of whether or not the QR Code is recognized. The daily validity check is carried out by the Officers in charge at the entrance of Sant'Anna premises.

EU and Extra-EU citizens can also:

- take a 2nd dose in Italy by registering on the [portale dell'Azienda USL Nordovest](#), only if they already possess a Fiscal Code and are already enrolled in the Regional Health System.

Complete vaccinations and foreign countries vaccination/healing certificates (equivalent and not)

Currently, the following vaccines have been authorized in Italy and in the EU:

- Pfizer-BioNtech Comirnaty vaccine
- Spikevax vaccine (Moderna)
- AstraZeneca Vaxzevria vaccine
- Janssen vaccine (Johnson & Johnson)

Foreign countries certificates of healing/vaccination

The person who has been vaccinated with one of the above-mentioned vaccines, within the EU or within one of the Countries [listed here](#), are allowed to present a EU Digital COVID Certificate or equivalent, whose QR Code is not recognized by the dedicated App.

Equivalent vaccinations

The equivalence of the Vaccination will be verified by the Infosalute group of the School.

The validity of those vaccination certificates is the same as for the Green Pass issued in Italy and EU, provided that they meet the following requirements.

- identification data of the owner (name, surname, date of birth);

- data relating to the vaccine (name and lot);
- date(s) of administration of the vaccine;
- identification data of the issuer of the certificate (State, Health Authority).

Vaccination certifications, in paper and/or digital format, must be accompanied by a sworn translation, if not produced in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French or Spanish.

Certificates without the above-mentioned requirements will not be considered valid in any case.

Certificates of Healing

The Certificates of Healing must contain at least the following content:

- holder's identification data (first name, last name, date of birth);
- information about the holder's previous SARS-CoV-2 infection following a positive test (date of first positive swab);
- Identifying data of the person who issued the certificate (State, Health Authority).

All certifications of recovery, in paper and/or digital format, must be accompanied by a sworn translation, if not produced in one of the following languages: Italian, English, French or Spanish.

If the validity of healing certificates is the same as that provided for the green COVID-19 certification (EU COVID digital certificate) issued by the Italian Government, they will therefore be recognized as valid by Infosalute Group, after verification of the requirements listed.

Procedure

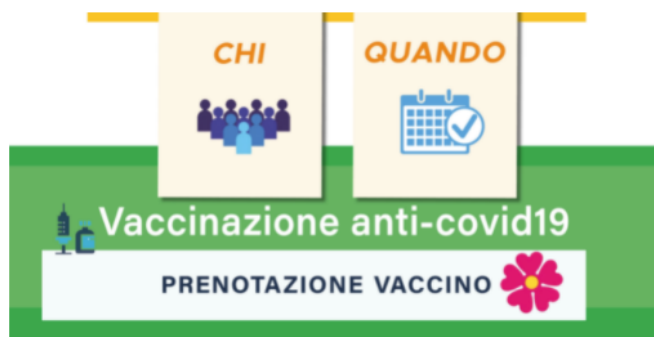
The entitled Offices (Infosalute and IRO) will request to provide those certificates of vaccination/healing no later than 10 days before the expected entry to School, in order to allow the verification.

Once Infosalute and IRO have checked the validity of the document/certification, the person will be noticed about the results and will receive all the information for entering the School.

Once the person has got a Fiscal Code and is enrolled in the Regional Health System, he/she can register the Certification at this site:
